



Pond-Dipping Adventure

Spend the day in the Swampy Woods having fun and cooking on fires, but also explore the Woodcote ponds, home to several rare species. Endless invertebrates overwinter in ponds and March is the time when frogs and toads spawn. We may even find newly-hatched tadpoles and perhaps some dragonfly nymphs waiting to emerge once the weather warms up.
